

Sport Premium Overview
Vision Statement: “Happy and Aiming High”

At Littlemoor Children’s Centre & School we believe Physical Education (PE) and Sport plays an important role in making our vision statement a reality for every pupil, with the potential to change young people’s lives for the better.

Through PE and Sport our children learn to develop the important qualities of discipline, resilience, communication, team work and ambition, leading to improved concentration, attitude and academic achievement.

We have welcomed the Government’s announcement in September 2016 to provide double the funding to improve provision of PE and sport and a healthy lifestyle in primary schools. We are committed to using this resource in developing high quality PE lessons, alongside greater opportunities for sporting and clubs for all our young people.

Sport Premium Grant

Funding for schools is calculated by the number of primary aged pupils (between the ages of 5 and 11) as at the annual census in January of each academic year.

What does the Sport Premium mean for our School?

We are working closely with our pyramid schools especially Campsmount Academy and have identified, through a self-review process, key areas to develop to ensure we can meet the high expectations in PE and Sport for our children.
