We welcome your gifts from Monday.

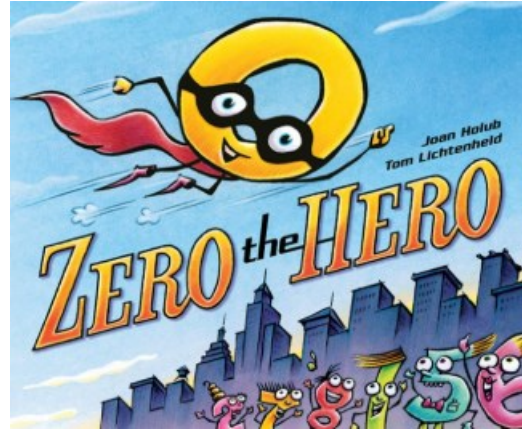

Every 10 days of school your child will celebrate with fun mathematical problem solving and reasoning challenges.

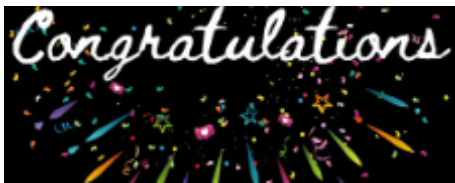
Challenges will include real life experiences and include essential life skills.
