Water Safety Reminder

As the weather becomes warmer, we would like to remind parents and carers about the importance of water safety.

Please speak with your child about:

- Staying away from rivers, lakes, canals, and ponds unless supervised
- Never going near water alone
- Always listening to adults and following safety rules
- Wearing appropriate safety equipment when near water

Children should also know:

- If they fall into water, they should try to float and shout for help
- They should never jump into water to rescue someone, but instead call for an adult immediately
