On Friday 5th May, the children took part in our own Coronation service, learning about the traditions and symbolism of the ceremony.

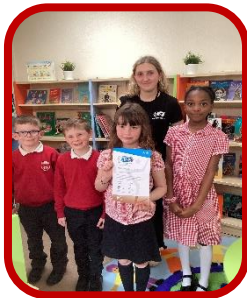
We are so grateful to a member of the Askern Town Council, Mr Gracey, who presented the children with a commemorative coin to mark this historic event.
