Our Nursery and Reception parents have enjoyed attending our Easter-themed stay and play sessions.



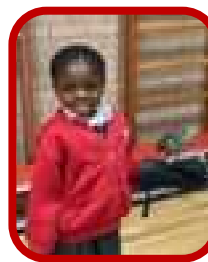
## ASPIRE
